USE OF YOUR INFORMATION

running of your properties or business. You will be taking full responsibility for not receive vital information sent to you regarding our service to you. This will not prevent us from contacting you via phone, SMS or email to fulfil our service to you.

ENQUIRIES

When you are making enquirers and you do not want your data used by us or our third parties you will have the opportunity to withhold your consent on our forms, over the telephone or in person. If you are an applicant requesting information on a property, viewing or general information, we will send you information regarding similar properties to the ones you have enquired about up to a maximum of two months at which time we will assume you have sought out a property or have found the information you had been enquiring about. If you are a Landlord or vendor contacting us for information regarding our services including sales and lettings but not limited to these services, we may continue to contact your for a maximum of two months at which point we will assume you have the required information or have found another party offering you this service.

With your consent to use your data we might also use this information to permit selected third parties to contact you with services that might be of benefit to you. The methods used to contact you could include but will not be limited to email, telephone, or in person.

You could be added to our bulk mailing list where we will be sending out information about third party services that we feel might be of interest to you or that will help you running your properties or business, we may also send you information regarding our services and information that could be vital to you regarding our business and any updates that will affect the use of your information. The information is used in the same way as any other enquiry outlined above, the information from our platforms may be used in reports containing personal information that you have provided and held/deleted in line with our policy above.

STORING YOUR PERSONAL DATA

Stored data is held in two different ways.

- 1. Online
- 2. On premises

Any data held in our premises may include but not be limited to paper, data on our computers. In their paper forms information may include but will not be limited to, signed tenancy agreements, signed paperer applications, check-in and inventory paperwork and singed guarantor forms. We keep all documentation for a maximum of 7 years for our record management compliance. When this information is not longer current the data is either archived and stored onsite in our locked or destroyed by a third-party destruction company or destroyed inline with local council guidance. If personal data has been recorded on paper, we will transfer this information to a digital format following our company policy, once this has been completed all paper

copies will be destroyed following company guidelines. Data on our computers is password protected and locked in our offices

All online data is stored on or systems Juvo, mail chimp, signable and our computers. We use Juvo as our back-office software, any information collated from our website, emails, manually entered from walk in customers or from phone calls are stored on Juvo and are stored on a cloud-based platform in Dublin (AWS – Amazon Web Services). Mailchimp is used for bulk emailing, information help on this system is limited to names email addresses if you would like to read more on mailchimps Privacy Policy. We use Signable to enable us to allow contract, application forms and guarantor forms to be signed at distance if you want to read more on Signable Privacy Policy.

When submitting any data to us in any form you agree to the transfer, storing or processing of this information/data. We will take all reasonable care to ensure this data/information is kept safe and secure in agreement with this privacy policy.
